The Mount Sinai Hospital Perinatal Bereavement Program provides bereavement services for families experiencing losses at any stage of pregnancy and those experiencing early infant loss. Referrals are accepted from patients, families and health care providers at any time following a loss. Women having medical terminations of pregnancy may also be referred to this program. Services are provided in a manner sensitive to individual and family circumstances and cultural beliefs.
